

This summer the project Dofins de Tramuntana is back, with the support of Galp Costa Brava, and funding from European Maritime and Fisheries Fund (EMFF) and the Catalan Government.

Dofins de Tramuntana is an initiative of SUBMON, which aims to implement marine stewardship strategies in the Cap de Creus area (Northern Catalonia). Our objective is to conserve and raise awareness of its natural, cultural and landscape values. The project wants to specially give visibility to the bottlenose dolphin, one of the key marine assets of this area.

The main goal of this year's campaign is to promote the conservation of the area's marine ecosystems in collaboration with the fishing sector. We will also continue our study of the bottlenose dolphin population in the Natural Park of the Cap de Creus and adjacent waters.
